

SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP WORKSHOP SERIES

A social entrepreneur starts a business with the aim of solving social problems or effecting change. At age 8, Jahkil Jackson became one of the top youth social entrepreneurs in the country by creating Project I Am NFP to build awareness to homelessness. Now 16, Jackson has led Project I Am's efforts in raising over \$550,000 and has impacted over 135,000 homeless people globally. Additionally, Jahkil became a successful best-selling author, youth advocate, student athlete and social entrepreneurship teacher.

Led by Jackson, the Don't Wait To Be Great workshop series brings community service and entrepreneurship together to educate and enrich youth using instruction and hands-on activities focused on the importance of philanthropy and entrepreneurship. This program mobilizes youth to engage in efforts to achieve major social objectives, including employment creation, poverty reduction, inclusion and integration.
